A fee of \$75.00 will be required for each set of specifications.

Specifications may be obtained at the Department of Purchasing Room 211, Municipal Building, 4233 Kennedy Boulevard, North Bergen, N.J. during regular business hours from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. daily, except Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays.

Bids for said contract must be based upon and in strict accordance with the aforesaid specifications.

All bids must be stated in words and figures and proposals must be made on the standard proposal form in the manner designated therein and required by specifications.

Bid proposals must be placed in a sealed envelope addressed to the Township of North Bergen, 4233 Kennedy Boulevard, North Bergen, New Jersey 07047, Attention: Purchasing Agent, along with the name of the project marked clearly on the outside envelope. Delivery of bid must be in person, Federal Express or Express Mail Service. No bids will be accepted after the date and time specified above.

All bids must be submitted on forms for that purpose to be obtained from Purchasing Agent.

All Contracts will be on standard form contracts which are available for inspection in the Law Department.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27, as well as the affirmative action requirements of the County of Hudson.

The Township of North Bergen reserves the right to waive informalities in bids and to reject any and all bids, if deemed in the best interest of the Township to do so.
