Key Responsibilities:

- **Plant Care & Maintenance**
 - Assist with daily cultivation tasks, including watering, feeding, and pruning plants
 - Monitor plant health and report any issues such as pests, diseases, or nutrient deficiencies to senior staff
 - Support the transplanting, trimming, and trellising of plants as needed
